




Methodology



- Audience: the population of Ukraine aged 18 and older in all regions, except for the temporarily occupied territories of Crimea and Donbas, as well as the territories where Ukrainian mobile network was not available at the time of the survey. The results are weighted using the current data from the State Statistics Service of Ukraine
- The sample is representative in terms of age, gender, and type of settlement
- Sample population: 1500 respondents
- o Survey method: CATI (Computer Assisted Telephone Interviewing). Based on a random sample of mobile phone numbers
- The margin of error of the study with the confidence interval of 0.95: does not exceed 2.5%.
- o Dates of the survey: July 25-27, 2023
- o Initiator of the survey: rs medienberatung GmbH










Do you connect your personal future with life in Ukraine?








Do you think war between Russia and Ukraine could have been avoided





Is the election of the President of Ukraine necessary in the current circumstances?











How effective is Western aid to Ukraine?












How much do you think each of these countries is a reliable ally of Ukraine?







How much do you think each of these countries is a reliable ally of Ukraine?






In your opinion, is Ukraine an equal partner for the West?




When do you think peace will come in Ukraine?






